Identifying Poison Ivy, Poison Sumac and Poison Oak




Read about the plants below and color them based on the description.

Poison Sumac

Medium Green Leaves that turn yellow, orange and red in the fall.

Leaves grown in sets of 11-13.



Tiny yellowish green flowers.


Berries are light green but turn whitish in the fall.

Stems are bright red.

Poison Ivy

Small hairs allow the vines to attach to trees and buildings.

Leaves grown in sets of three.



Medium Green Leaves that turn yellow, orange and red in the fall.

Stems are green to brownish.

Berries are pale green to white in color.

Poison Oak

Shiny, bright green Leaves that turn red in the fall.

Leaves grown in sets of three and are shaped like oak leaves.



Stems are green to brownish.

Berries are light green.
